Additional Insured Issues is a STAND ALONE course and is not part of the CRIS Core curriculum; however, it can be used to update the Construction Risk and Insurance Specialist (CRIS) designation. It explores coverage issues such as "other insurance" concerns; recent revisions to the most widely used CGL additional insured endorsements; problematic coverage exposures; and relevant case law. The course also addresses insured status under other construction-related lines of insurance, explaining the coverage features typical of each line and the risktransfer significance of insured status under these policies.
